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HUMAN CAPITAL AS ONE OF THE DRIVERS OF RELIABLE VALUE OF MEDICAL ENTITIES USING THE EXAMPLE OF POLAND -IMPLICATIONS FOR GLOBAL MEDICAL MARKET PARTICIPANTS

Abstract:

This paper constitutes a contribution to a new discussion on the adequacy of existing company valuation methods with regard to the specific nature of medical entities in Poland. The author points out the shortcomings of existing theories.
